Banjo Corporation is *Going Green!*

In our continuing journey to becoming a green company, Banjo is making another effort to be more environmentally friendly by offering customers a paperless invoicing option. Customers can now receive their invoicing by email sent directly from our data system.



Banjo has in recent years adopted a “Going Green” policy by recycling cardboard, paper, ink toner cartridges, batteries, light bulbs, plastic bottles and aluminum cans.

In order to reduce energy, Banjo participated in the Energizing Indiana program that recycled older fixtures for higher efficiency ones and reduced the number of light bulbs from four to two per fixture. Banjo has also installed motion sensing overhead lighting in its large warehouse spaces, allowing the overhead lights to remain off when employees are not in the area.

Banjo’s maintenance department has furthered the effort by recycling used oil, steel, aluminum, copper and wood. Banjo also regrinds its polypropylene material to be reused in producing additional products.
